

Mission Valley Christian Academy, a non-denominational ACSI certified Christian school and the premier private school in Lake County, is seeking a highly motivated, engaged, and passionate **High School Math Teacher** for the 2024-2025 school year.

MVCA is a smaller school located in Polson Montana and surrounded by the beautiful Mission Mountains and at the southern end of Flathead Lake. Our enrollment will run between 150 - 160 students for this year and everyone here is like family. The salary is \$29k for first year teachers for the nine months between September and May. Benefits include medical and dental benefits, professional development and certification costs, and lower tuition rates for students of teachers.

The minimum requirement for this position is a four-year degree, preferably in mathematics or education with a mathematics concentration, and a willingness to start ACSI certification during the first year at MVCA.

MVCA is seeking ideal candidates who have the ability to articulate a Biblical worldview and consider themselves to be 21st Century educators who embrace current best practices. Candidates should possess a desire to grow within a professional learning community and be enthusiastic about teaching, learning, and Christ. Candidates should exhibit a passion for teaching and working with students and uphold the highest standards of excellence professionally and personally. Candidates should be willing to collaborate with staff members and families and be reflective practitioners. Candidates must agree with MVCA's Statement of Faith and regularly attend a local church body.

- Proficient in the use and integration of technology in the classroom.
- Skilled in maintaining records and committed to parental involvement/communication.
- Demonstrates strong written and verbal skills.
- Knows and applies knowledge of current professional literature and best practices.
- Evidence of excellent verbal communication skills.
- Exhibits strong problem-solving skills.
- Shows skill and sensitivity in working with all members of the school community.

MVCA Statement of Faith:

There is only one God, who is infinitely perfect, existing eternally in three persons; Father, Son and Holy Spirit (Isaiah 43:10; John 1:1-3, 3:16; 2 Corinthians 13:14)
